Food Vendor Rules & Policies

- 1) PLEASE NOTE: There are no access to electrical hook-ups. YOU must bring your own generator.
- 2) Food Booth size is 10x10. Please bring your own trash receptacles. The Feast of Lanterns will determine where your placement will be. Food vendors will not be allowed to set up on the lawn.
- 3) Set up time: You may begin set up as early as 7:00 am. When unloading please obey all traffic rules and personnel directing traffic. After unloading, please move your vehicle immediately to street parking. Please set up in your designated area within your booth space. Be prepared to adjust your booth space should you receive a request from Feast of Lanterns staff. You must respond to their direction.
- 4) All set up must be completed by 9:00 am. You MUST be ready for the Health Department Inspector and sign off by 9:00 am - without exception. Please have your current Health Department certificate and copy of insurance rider and permit available upon request by the Health Department Inspector and/or Feast of Lanterns Staff.
- 5) Please ensure that your food and presentation are accessible to disabled customers.
- 6) Clean Up: All vendors are requested to keep their area free of litter and to use the on-site dumpsters provided by the Park. Keep in mind that only polystyrene free products will be permitted. All food vendors should be particularly careful in disposing of an grease or oil. Please bring an appropriate receptacle for this purpose, as well as a fire extinguisher.
- 7) Break down time is 9:00pm. No vehicles will be allowed in Lovers Point Park before 9:00pm to break down.

9) Port-a-Potties will be available at the Park.

10) This year the Feast of Lanterns is committed and partnering with the City of Pacific Grove to reduce waste. As a vendor you will be required to use only recyclable, compostable and biodegradable food ware such as plates napkins, forks, cups and spoons. (PGMC 11.99.030)
